

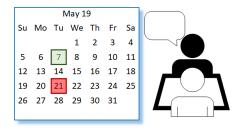
Deployment Process ...At-a-Glance

Starting this spring, the Office of Information Technology will begin upgrading computer workstations to the Windows 10 operating system and Office 2016 applications suite. In addition to the new software, the thin-client hardware will also be replaced.

In order to ensure that the software and hardware upgrade is successful, and that you are provided with the training and support necessary to adjust to this change, the deployment process will be implemented as follows:

- Training and support

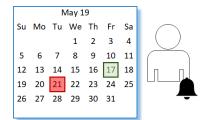
Where does it happen?

- Training date, time and location

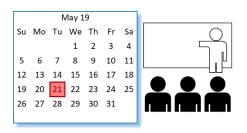
Where does it happen?

While you attend training, your software/hardware is upgraded

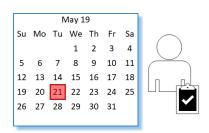
Where does it happen?

After training, log in to the new system and perform a system check with your trainer

A trainer checks in with you to answer questions and provide assistance, as needed

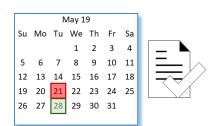
Where does it happen?
